

Seminar Schedule with Tentative Times

The times listed here are tentative so be sure to check the final schedule times that will be in your Seminar Packet.

For attendees who are not staying at the hotel and are driving in the morning to meet the bus, please plan on arriving at the hotel at least 15 minutes before the departing times listed below.

Wednesday, May 8, 8:30 am – 5:30 pm We will board the bus at the hotel in the morning for a full day visiting four glass museums in 3 states. First stop is the National Museum of Cambridge Glass in Cambridge, Ohio, followed by the National Imperial Glass Museum in Bellaire, Ohio, where we will have our box lunch. Next stop is the Fostoria Glass Museum in Moundsville, WV, ending the day at the Oglebay Institute Glass Museum in Wheeling, WV. We expect to arrive back at the hotel about 5:30 pm with dinner on your own.

Wednesday, May 8, 6:30 pm – 8:30 pm Come and meet with your fellow seminar attendees at the Welcome Reception, sponsored by the NAGC Board. A cash bar will be available. Check your seminar packet for the designated room.

Thursday, May 9, 8:45 am – 5:00 pm Traveling by coach around the city of Pittsburgh for the day, we will leave in the morning for our first tour at the Heinz History Center. Another short bus trip brings us to the Cathedral of Learning, first stopping at the Cathedral Café with its many choices for lunch on your own, then we will begin our tour of the Nationality Rooms. The Heinz Memorial Chapel is a short walk across the green from the Cathedral of Learning. After our tour there, we will board the bus for our last stop of the day to see the Tiffany windows at the Calvary United Methodist Church. Our bus is expected to arrive back at the hotel about 5:00 pm and the evening is on your own.

Friday, May 10, 8:30 am – 4:30 pm We will begin the day traveling by coach to the countryside home of Harley Trice to see his wonderful glass collection. Then we leave for the Westmoreland Museum of Art in Greensburg, PA, where we will have our box lunch and tour the Museum's glass pieces. Our last visit will be to the Duncan & Miller Glass Museum at its new location in Washington, PA. We are scheduled to arrive back at the hotel about 4:30 pm with the evening on your own.

Saturday, May 11, 9:00 am – 4:00 pm The day's meeting will take place in the hotel's Duquesne Room starting with two glass presentations, followed by introductions of the four area glass organizations and discussion of their glass displays set up around the room. After the box lunch and time to view the displays, we will have the NAGC Annual Meeting and then two more presentations, adjourning about 4:00 pm.

Saturday, May 11, 6:30 pm – 10:00 pm The doors to the Duquesne Room will open at 6:30 pm for viewing the glass pieces available in the silent auction and a cash bar will open for drinks. After our banquet dinner, winners of the silent auction pieces will be announced.
